Dear Director Coats:

We are writing to request a briefing on incidental collection of U.S. persons and the unmasking of U.S. persons. The scope of our request includes practices by all agencies overseen by you and all programs administered by those agencies.

At a hearing on May 8, former Director of National Intelligence James Clapper testified that, at least in the case of Section 702 collection, records of unmasking requests exist. We ask that you instruct all agencies overseen by you to preserve all records related to unmasking requests that involve U.S. person elected officials, U.S. person candidates for elected office, or U.S. persons associated with political campaigns.
