Dear Professor Richman:

On June 8, 2017, the Committee sought from you copies of memoranda that Mr. Comey drafted and provided to you memorializing his interactions with President Trump. You reportedly told the media that you received four memoranda from Mr. Comey. 2

However, on a phone call on June 13, 2017, you declined to voluntarily provide the Committee with the memoranda or to answer questions, and instead referred the Committee to Special Counsel Mueller's office. The Special Counsel's office has since clarified that it does not speak for you.

Thus, the Committee seeks answers from you directly. The Committee would like to schedule a voluntary transcribed interview with you, which would be conducted in private. In advance of your interview, please produce the following documents to the Committee no later than November 1, 2017:

- 1. All communications with James Comey, the FBI, Special Counsel Mueller's office, or the media related to Director Comey's interactions with Donald J. Trump, including communications related to the memoranda he drafted memorializing his interactions with Donald J. Trump;
- 2. Copies of Mr. Comey's memoranda;

- 3. Records sufficient to reflect the timeline and chain of custody of the copies of Mr. Comey's memoranda that you received;
- 4. All communications with Mr. Comey about the Clinton email investigation, including those related to his public statement on July 5, 2016, and letters to Congress on October 28, 2016, and November 6, 2016;
- 5. All records related to Mr. Comey's public statement and letters to Congress, including preliminary drafts; and
- 6. All communications with Mr. Comey concerning his firing as FBI Director.
