1 On page 89, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:

3 “(14) DISCLOSURE OF SOCIAL SECURITY INFORMATION.—
4

5 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may
6 not grant registered provisional immigrant status to an alien under this section unless the
7 alien fully discloses to the Secretary all the
8 names and Social Security account numbers
9 that the alien has ever used to obtain employment in the United States.

1 “(B) REVOCATION OF GRANTED STATUS.—

2 If the Secretary determines that an alien pre-
3 viously granted registered provisional immi-
4 grant status under this section has not com-
5 plied with the requirement in subparagraph (A),
6 the Secretary shall revoke the status of the
7 alien as a registered provisional immigrant.

8 “(C) NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTFUL ASSIGN-

9 EES.—The Secretary may disclose information
10 received from an alien pursuant to a disclosure
11 under subparagraph (A) to any Federal or
12 State agency authorized to collect such informa-
13 tion in order to enable such agency to notify
14 each named individual or rightful assignee of
15 the Social Security account number concerned
16 of the alien’s misuse of such name or number
17 to obtain employment.
