Viz:

1 At the end of the amendment, add the following:

2 (5) WHISTLEBLOWER PROTECTION.—

3 (A) IN GENERAL.—No officer, employee,

4 agent, contractor, or subcontractor of the judi-

5 cial branch may discharge, demote, threaten,

6 suspend, harass, or in any other manner dis-

7 criminate against an employee in the terms and

8 conditions of employment because of any lawful

9 act done by the employee to provide informa-

10 tion, cause information to be provided, or other-

11 wise assist in an investigation regarding any

1 possible violation of Federal law or regulation,  
2 or misconduct, by a judge, justice, or any other  
3 employee in the judicial branch, which may as-  
4 sist in the investigation of the possible violation  
5 or misconduct.

6 (B) CIVIL ACTION.—An employee injured  
7 by a violation of subparagraph (A) may, in a  
8 civil action, obtain appropriate relief.
