I began my legal career at Gallucci, Hopkins & Theisen, P.C., in Fort Wayne, Indiana, a firm that primarily worked on labor and employment matters. During that time I handled employment litigation, including discrimination claims, in the Indiana federal and state courts, as well as before the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the National Labor Relations Board. I also assisted with contract negotiations with various unions. When Gallucci Hopkins & Theisen merged with Barnes & Thornburg, I worked on complex civil litigation in addition to my employment practice.

In 2002, I left Barnes & Thornburg to join what became Theisen, Bowers & Brady, a boutique employment law firm. After five years, I accepted an invitation to join Haller & Colvin, P.C. While at Haller & Colvin, I have continued my work on labor and employment issues, and have also represented clients in complex civil litigation in state and federal courts throughout the country.

In addition to my practice in state and federal courts, I continue to regularly represent clients in matters before the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and related local agencies, the National Labor Relations Board, the Department of Labor Wage and Hour Division, and various Occupational Safety and Health Administrations. I also continue to represent clients in contract negotiations with unions and in arbitrations related to employee discipline under collective bargaining agreements.

This case entailed the representation of two brothers in connection with a suit brought by their sister. Plaintiff asserted that my clients had breached their fiduciary duties relating to two family businesses that the three siblings jointly owned. We filed counterclaims against plaintiff (and certain related people and entities) alleging conversion of hundreds of thousands of dollars from the family companies. I acted as lead counsel, developing case strategy and leading an extensive discovery effort, which ultimately resulted in the settlement of the case at mediation.

2. *E.T. Prods., LLC v. D.E. Miller Holdings, Inc.*, Case No. 2:13-CV-424, 154 F. Supp. 3d 755 (N.D. Ind. 2016), *aff'd*, 872 F.3d 464 (7th Cir. 2017).

This case entailed the representation of a buyer of assets, which sought to enforce a non-compete provision in an asset purchase agreement. The posture of this case was complicated by the settlement of related litigation before my firm was retained. On cross-motions for summary judgment, the district court decided in favor of the seller. On appeal, the Seventh Circuit agreed with our position that the non-compete agreement was enforceable, but concluded that there was no evidence that the seller had violated it. I served as lead counsel during both the trial and appellate proceedings and argued the case before the Seventh Circuit.

3. *Driver v. D. Mosley Trucking, Inc.*, Case No. 13-4074 (W.D. Ark.).

This was a complex case arising out of a truck roll-over, which resulted in a brain injury to an elderly plaintiff. My firm represented a manufacturer of steel, which plaintiff claimed had failed to properly load and secure the steel on the truck. I was responsible for case strategy and discovery. We conducted extensive expert discovery to establish that the crash occurred as a
