Re: “The Truth Revealed: Hidden Facts Regarding Nazis and Swiss Banks” (Feb. 3 Hearing)

Chairman Grassley,

We write with profound gratitude for your leadership and moral clarity in convening the upcoming Senate Judiciary Committee hearing, “The Truth Revealed: Hidden Facts Regarding Nazis and Swiss Banks.” In an era when history is too often distorted, denied, or diluted, your determination to bring documented truth to light is both historic and urgently needed.

We write to you as leaders of the Israel Economic Forum (IEF)—a private, invitation-only global community of senior business leaders committed to strengthening Israel and the Jewish people through relationship-building and strategic engagement. Our members span 26 countries and collectively represent approximately 750,000 employees and \$170 billion in combined annual revenue. We mention this only to convey that this letter reflects not a single voice, but a serious global community deeply committed to truth, memory, and accountability.

For decades, survivors and their families were told—explicitly or implicitly—to accept ambiguity, partial disclosures, and the assumption that certain institutions would never be held fully accountable. Your Committee’s work makes clear that America will not allow the record of Nazi crimes and their enablers to be buried behind secrecy, legal maneuvering, or institutional obstruction. This hearing is not only an act of oversight—it is an act of historical integrity.



For one of us (Avi), this issue is also deeply personal. I come from a family of Holocaust survivors. In families like mine, the Holocaust is not a chapter in a book—it is carried in silences at the dinner table, in old photographs with missing faces, and in the knowledge that evil often requires not only perpetrators, but enablers—those who finance it, facilitate it, and conceal the evidence afterward.

That is why this hearing matters. It is about more than Switzerland. More than Credit Suisse. More than UBS. It is about a moral line: that complicity has a cost; that deception across generations cannot be normalized; and that truth—however delayed—must still be pursued. For a community of business leaders, it is also about the integrity of institutions: when financial entities conceal or distort historical truth, they erode trust in the very foundations of the marketplace.

Importantly, the Committee’s leadership sends a powerful message at a time of rising antisemitism around the world. As extremists attempt to glorify the Third Reich and rewrite history, your work affirms that the United States will not look away. It will confront falsehood with fact—and defend the integrity of documented truth.

We are grateful for your courage and your commitment to this work. Ensuring the full documentary record is preserved in a public repository will be an enduring service to history. We hope this hearing leads to the fullest possible public accounting, and to meaningful accountability where decades of deception have occurred.
