

To Chairman Grassley and Members of the Senate Judiciary Committee,

Thank you for your willingness to confront history honestly and publicly. As a proud Jewish American and the granddaughter of Holocaust survivors – including my Grandmother Lilly, a 96-year-old Auschwitz survivor – I carry the stories of my family with me in everything I do. Those stories taught me early on that truth is not guaranteed to survive unless people actively protect it.

As an artist and creator with a large online platform that includes more than 14 million followers, I have chosen to speak directly to younger generations about the Holocaust, antisemitism, and what happens when lies are allowed to replace facts. I have seen how quickly misinformation spreads and how easily history can be distorted when there is no clear record to point to. That is why your efforts to expose the role Swiss banks played in collaborating with the Nazis, and the decades spent concealing that truth, feel so important. When institutions hide their actions, it does lasting damage not only to victims, but to public understanding itself.

This work carries special urgency right now. Since October 7, the largest mass murder of Jews since the Holocaust, I have watched attempts to deny, minimize, or justify violence against my community spread across social media in real time. Speaking out has not always been easy, but silence only allows hatred and deceit to grow stronger. Clear facts, documented history, and accountability are essential tools in pushing back.

By bringing this truth into the public record and demanding accountability after decades of deception, the Committee is doing more than correcting history. You are also helping ensure that future generations inherit facts instead of falsehoods, and clarity instead of confusion. That matters deeply to me, to my family, and to the millions of young people who are still learning what history has to teach them.

Thank you for your leadership and your commitment to truth.
