19	Proclamation 5928 of December 27, 1988.
20	SEC. 3. DATA FIELD IN THE NATIONAL MISSING AND UN-
21	IDENTIFIED PERSONS SYSTEM RELATED TO
22	FEDERAL LAND AND TERRITORIAL WATERS.
23	The Attorney General shall include in the National
24	Missing and Unidentified Persons System a data field to
25	indicate whether the last known location of the missing
