AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE intended
to be proposed by Mr. TILLIS

Viz:

1 Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the fol-
2 lowing:

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tracking and Report-
5 ing Absent Community-Members Everywhere Act” or the
6 “TRACE Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

8 In this Act:

9 (1) ATTORNEY GENERAL.—The term “Attorney
10 General” means the Attorney General, acting

1 through the Director of the National Institute of
2 Justice.

3 (2) FEDERAL LAND.—The term “Federal land”
4 means land owned by the United States that is
5 under the administrative jurisdiction of—

6 (A) the Secretary of Agriculture;

7 (B) the Secretary of the Interior (except
8 land held in trust for the benefit of an Indian
9 Tribe); or

10 (C) the Secretary of Defense only with re-
11 spect to land and water resources projects ad-
12 ministered by the Corps of Engineers.

13 (3) TERRITORIAL WATERS OF THE UNITED
14 STATES.—The term “territorial waters of the United
15 States” means all waters of the territorial sea of the
16 United States, 12 nautical miles wide, adjacent to
17 the coast of the United States and seaward of the
18 territorial baseline, as described in Presidential
19 Proclamation 5928 of December 27, 1988.

20 **SEC. 3. DATA FIELD IN THE NATIONAL MISSING AND UN-**
21 **IDENTIFIED PERSONS SYSTEM RELATED TO**
22 **FEDERAL LAND AND TERRITORIAL WATERS.**

23 The Attorney General shall include in the National
24 Missing and Unidentified Persons System a data field to
25 indicate whether the last known location of the missing

1 person was confirmed or was suspected to have been on
2 Federal land or in the territorial waters of the United
3 States, including any specific location details about the
4 unit of Federal land or the area of the territorial waters
5 of the United States that was the last known location of
6 the missing person.

7 **SEC. 4. REPORT.**

8 Not later than January 15 of the second calendar
9 year that begins after the date of enactment of this Act,
10 and annually thereafter, the Attorney General shall submit
11 to the Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate and the
12 Committee on the Judiciary of the House of Representa-
13 tives a report that contains, for the previous calendar year,
14 the number of cases in the National Missing and Unidenti-
15 fied Persons System for which the missing person's last
16 known location was confirmed or was suspected to have
17 been on Federal land or in the territorial waters of the
18 United States.
