- 22 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-
- graph (2), for purposes of any civil action under sec-
- 24 tion 2333 of this title, a defendant shall be deemed
- 25 to have consented to personal jurisdiction in such

10	2346 et seq.);
11	"(ii) any form of assistance, however
12	provided, under section 481 of the Foreign
13	Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2291)
14	for international narcotics control and law
15	enforcement; or
16	"(iii) any form of assistance, however
17	provided, under chapter 9 of part II of the
18	Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C.
19	2349bb et seq.); or
20	"(B) in the case of a defendant benefiting
21	from a waiver or suspension of section 1003 of
22	the Anti-Terrorism Act of 1987 (22 U.S.C.
23	5202) after the date that is 120 days after the
24	date of enactment of this subsection—

1	"(i) continues to maintain any office,
2	headquarters, premises, or other facilities
3	or establishments within the jurisdiction of
4	the United States; or
5	"(ii) establishes or procures any of-
