

A bill to fund law enforcement and safeguard American communities

The Senate Judiciary Committee's title of the targeted reconciliation bill helps end Democrats' partisan shutdown of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

The revised Judiciary Committee's legislative text:

- 1. Fully funds the immigration enforcement missions of U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) through 2029**, providing CBP \$13.02B to hire, pay and train personnel, while carrying out its mission of securing the border and protecting American communities from illicit drugs and contraband.
- 2. Fully funds the immigration enforcement missions of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) through 2029**, providing ICE \$31.075B to support the brave law enforcement officers who put their lives on the line to keep Americans safe from violent criminals and potential terrorists.
- 3. Boosts law enforcement and immigration enforcement efforts through 2029**, providing DHS \$2.5B to ensure the department's critical national security and law enforcement work isn't further interrupted by Democrats' radical, defund-the-police agenda.
