Purpose: To ensure that “effective control” specifically includes prevention of unlawful entries into the United States, including entries by terrorists, other unlawful aliens, instruments of terrorism, narcotics, and other contraband, and triggers the initiation of processing for registered provisional immigrant status, and to eliminate the use of the terms “effectiveness rate” and “high risk sectors” from the bill.

2 lowing: “to achieve and maintain effective control.”

3 Beginning on page 9, strike line 14 and all that fol-
4 lows through “(7)” on page 10, line 8, and insert the fol-
5 lowing:

6 (3) EFFECTIVE CONTROL.—The term “effective
7 control” means the ability to achieve and maintain

1 operational control (as defined in section 2(b) of the
2 Secure Fence Act of 2006 (Public Law 109–367).

3 (4) SOUTHERN BORDER.—The term “Southern
4 border” means the international border between the
5 United States and Mexico.

7 On page 10, line 16, strike “in high risk border sec-
8 tors along the Southern border”.

9 On page 14, lines 11 and 12, strike “in all high risk
10 border sectors”.

11 On page 17, line 2, strike the em dash and all that
12 follows through line 8, and insert “effective control.”.

13 On page 17, strike lines 17 and 18, and insert the
14 following: “achieve and maintain effective control.”.

15 On page 19, lines 11 and 12, strike “in all high risk
16 border sectors”.

17 Beginning on page 23, strike line 17 and all that fol-
18 lows through page 24, line 4, and insert the following:

2 sectors”.

3 On page 59, line 11, strike “the effectiveness rate”
4 and insert “the extent effective control has been
5 achieved”.
