Purpose: To prohibit an alien from becoming a registered provisional immigrant if the Secretary determines it is likely that the immigrant would receive State means-tested assistance or in the absence of such a determination, any of the following federal assistance: Medicaid, the State children's health insurance program (CHIP), the Affordable Care Act premium assistance tax credit, the supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP), the temporary assistance for needy families program (TANF), or supplemental security income benefits (SSI).

22 efits under a State temporary assist-
