AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. SESSIONS

Viz:

1       At the end of subtitle G of title III, add the following:

2   **SEC. 3720. PENALTIES FOR OVERSTAYING A VISA.**

3       Section 222(g) (8 U.S.C. 1202(g)) is amended by  
4 adding at the end the following:

5       “(3) An alien who has been admitted on the basis  
6 of a nonimmigrant visa and remained in the United States  
7 beyond the period of stay authorized by the such visa shall  
8 be imprisoned—

9       “(A) except as provided in subparagraph (B),  
10      for a period of not less than 60 days and not more  
11      than 90 days; or

1           “(B) if removal of the alien can be accom-  
2           plished in fewer than 90 days, for such period as is  
3           necessary to remove the alien.”.
