Dear Mr. Kushner:

The Committee seeks from you all information you have related to the meeting you attended on June 9, 2016, at Trump Tower, and related matters. The Committee would like to schedule a transcribed interview to be taken in private. Please contact the Committee no later than October 20, 2017, to schedule the interview.

In advance of your interview, please produce the following documents to the Committee no later than October 30, 2017:

1. All documents¹ related to the June 9, 2016 meeting or any other meeting or effort to arrange a meeting with Natalia Veselnitskaya or Rinat Akhmetshin, including all documents provided during the meeting and all documents relating to scheduling, what happened during the meeting(s), and any related actions taken after the meeting(s);

¹ The term “**document**” means any written, recorded, or graphic matter of any nature whatsoever, regardless of how recorded, and whether original or copy, including, but not limited to, the following: agreements; papers; memoranda; correspondence; reports; studies; reviews; analyses; graphs; diagrams; photographs; charts; tabulations; presentations; working papers; records; records of interviews; desk files; notes; letters; notices; confirmations; telegrams; faxes, telexes, receipts; appraisals; interoffice and intra office communications; electronic mail (e-mail); electronic messages; text messages; contracts; cables; recordings, notations or logs of any type of conversation, telephone call, meeting or other communication; bulletins; printed matter; computer printouts; teletype; invoices; transcripts; audio or video recordings; statistical or informational accumulations; data processing cards or worksheets; computer stored or generated documents; computer databases; computer disks and formats; machine readable electronic files; data or records maintained on a computer; instant messages; diaries; questionnaires and responses; data sheets; summaries; minutes; bills; accounts; estimates; projections; comparisons; messages; and similar or related materials. A document bearing any notation not a part of the original text is to be considered a separate document. A draft or non-identical copy is a separate document within the meaning of this term.

The term “**communication**” means each manner or means of disclosure or exchange of information, regardless of means utilized, whether oral, electronic, by document or otherwise, and whether face to face, in meeting, by telephone, mail, telex, facsimile, computer, discussions, releases, delivery, or otherwise.

2. All communications to, from, or copied to you relating to Rob Goldstone, Emin Agalarov, Aras Agalarov, Natalia Veselnitskaya, Rinat Akhmetshin, Anatoli Samochornov, Irakly (Ike) Kaveladze, Christopher Steele, Aleksej Gubarev, Webzilla B.V., XBT Holdings S.A., Alfa Group, Dmitry Peskov, Vladimir Putin, the Ritz Carlton Moscow Hotel, Carter Page, Igor Sechin, Sergei Ivanov, Igor Divyekin, Sergei Millian, Dmitry Medvedev, Michael G. Flynn, Michael T. Flynn, Jill Stein, Konstantin Kosachev, Viktor Yanukovych, Sergei Kislyak, Yuri Ushakov, Anton Vaino, Mikhail Kalugin, Andrei Bondarev, Mikhail Fridman, Petr Aven, German Khan, Oleg Govorun, Sergey Lavrov, Rosneft, Sergei Kiriyenko, and Oleg Solodukhin. This shall include any documents referring to any of the aforementioned using alternate spellings, pseudonyms, nicknames, abbreviations, or codes;
3. All documents concerning efforts to obtain, disclose, or disseminate “hacked” emails or other electronic data belonging to or housed on the servers of the Democratic National Committee (DNC), John Podesta, Hillary Clinton, or the 2016 U.S. presidential campaign of Hillary Clinton by WikiLeaks or any other media, news leaks, or hacking organization (e.g., Guccifer 2.0, DCLeaks);
4. All documents relating to any attempts or actions taken by you or the Trump campaign to obtain information during the 2016 presidential campaign about Hillary Clinton from: Russian government officials, associates, or representatives; any individuals who purported to act or whom you believed to be acting on behalf of Russian government officials, associates, or representatives; or anyone who you have reason to believe may have obtained the information from any such individuals;
5. All documents relating to any attempts or actions taken by you or the Trump campaign to obtain, coordinate, or otherwise use information obtained from individuals associated with the Russian government’s attempts to influence the United States 2016 presidential election;
6. All communications concerning efforts by Russian government officials, associates, or representatives or any individuals who purported to act or whom you believed to be acting on behalf of Russian government officials, associates, or representatives to identify voters or potential voters for targeted advertising, marketing, or social media contact in support of the Trump campaign or other efforts to elect Donald J. Trump as president of the United States;
7. All communications concerning the termination of James Comey as FBI director;
8. All communications concerning the termination or resignation of Lt. General Michael Flynn as national security advisor;
9. All documents concerning any meetings with former Russian Ambassador Sergei Kislyak;

10. All communications with, copied to, or concerning Sergey Gorkov, Vnesheconombank (“VEB Bank”), Vneshtorgbank (“VTB Bank”), or Sberbank;
11. All documents concerning a meeting in the Seychelles that reportedly occurred in or about January 2017 between Erik Prince and representatives of the Russian government; and
12. Sections 19, 20B.1, 20B.6 of your SF 86, including any additional materials that may have been submitted to supplement your original submission.
