

Dear General Kelly and Deputy Attorney General Rosenstein:

On Sunday, Deputy Attorney General Rosenstein stated: "If anyone did infiltrate or surveil participants in a presidential campaign for inappropriate purposes, we need to know about it and take appropriate action." We agree.

According to press reports, General Kelly is arranging a meeting with Justice Department officials and Congressional leaders to review certain classified information allegedly responsive to requests for documents from the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence. We write to express our interest in attending such a meeting and in support of providing Congress with documents necessary to conduct oversight of these issues.


