I have reviewed the questionnaire submitted to the Senate Judiciary Committee in May of 2017 in connection with my nomination to the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida. Incorporating the additional information listed below, I certify that the information contained in these documents is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate:

**Questions 9 & 15(a):**

My term on the Judicial Nominating Commission for Florida's 3rd District Court of Appeal expired in January 2019.

**Question 11(a):**

My term as President of the Miami Chapter of the American Enterprise Institute's ("AEI") Enterprise Club Miami ended in 2018.

My term as Campaign Chair for the American Israel Public Affairs Committee's ("AIPAC") Miami Club ended in 2018.

My term on the Florida Congressional Committee's ("FCC") Executive Committee ended in 2018.

**Question 16(b):**

On November 21, 2018, the Hon. Ketanji Brown Jackson, United States District Court for the District of Columbia, dismissed under the doctrine of *forum non conveniens* all of the Plaintiffs' claims in the case of *Air Crash Over the S. Indian Ocean*, No. 16-mc-00184-KBJ (D.D.C. 2016). We will be filing a notice of appeal on behalf of our clients in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

**Question 17:**

1. *Air Crash Over the S. Indian Ocean*, No. 16-mc-00184-KBJ (D.D.C. 2016) (Jackson, J.).
