4 A pregnant detainee in the custody of the Secretary
5 of Homeland Security or the Secretary of Health and
6 Human Services shall have access to health care services,
7 including comprehensive services relating to reproductive
8 health care and pregnancy, including—

9 (1) prenatal care;

- 1 (2) comprehensive counseling and assistance;
- 2 (3) postpartum follow-up;
- 3 (4) lactation services; and
- 4 (5) abortion services.
