17 "(2) REQUIREMENTS.—A certification under
18 paragraph (1) regarding an emergency shall in19 clude—

20 "(A) a short statement of facts in support
21 of the emergency; and

22 "(B) an explanation of why the facts re-23 quire disclosure without delay.".
