

# WRITTEN TESTIMONY OF JULIE MARZOUK, ESQ.

## Senate Judiciary Committee: Joint Subcommittee- Crime and Counterterrorism, Border Security and Immigration

### Hearing: Biden's Afghan Parolee Program- A Trojan Horse with Flawed Vetting and Deadly Consequences

January 14, 2026  
Washington, D.C.

#### I. Introduction

Since 2022, the U.S. government has granted hundreds of millions of dollars to the states for Afghan immigration legal services.<sup>1</sup> The Department of Health and Human Services under the Biden Administration allowed states to subgrant this money to non-profits of their choosing with virtually no transparency and no meaningful federal oversight.<sup>2</sup>

States, wittingly or unwittingly, used this discretion to channel federal funds to non-profits in the United States that support Hamas.<sup>3</sup> States obscured their obligations under federal contracting and grant rules, including the duty to ensure that all grantees do not support terrorism.<sup>4</sup> Organizations such as the Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR) were chosen as Afghan immigration providers.<sup>5</sup>

CAIR masquerades as a Muslim civil rights group; but it is not.<sup>6</sup> CAIR was formed by the political founder of Hamas, Mousa Abu Marzook, with the explicit purpose of

advancing Hamas's agenda in America.<sup>7</sup> In 1993, the FBI wiretapped the meeting where CAIR was created.<sup>8</sup> The transcript details how the Muslim Brotherhood needed an organization that looked legitimate and could interact with American civic society.<sup>9</sup>

CAIR was named as an unindicted co-conspirator in the 2008 Holy Land Foundation trial, the largest terrorist-financing case in U.S. history.<sup>10</sup> In 2009, a federal judge confirmed that "the government has produced ample evidence to establish the association of CAIR with . . . Hamas."<sup>11</sup> The current National Executive Director of CAIR, Nihad Awad, the same person who was at that wiretapped Philadelphia meeting in 1993, continues to express his support of Hamas.<sup>12</sup> He proclaimed his "happiness" at seeing the Hamas terrorist assault on Israel on October 7, 2023.<sup>13</sup>

After the U.S. withdrawal from Afghanistan, the Biden Administration paroled Afghans into the United States and granted money to immigration service non-profits, effectively delegating one of its most sensitive functions, screening and advising noncitizens on eligibility for asylum and other forms of immigration relief to organizations that themselves have supported terrorism.<sup>14</sup>

CAIR—California alone received more than fifteen million dollars in federal HHS/ORR money.<sup>15</sup> The State of Washington gave CAIR more than one million dollars in federal immigration funding.<sup>16</sup>

Lutheran Immigration and Refugees Services (LIRS) received \$221 million federal HHS/ORR dollars.<sup>17</sup> LIRS, sub-granted at least \$1.1 million dollars of federal Afghan

money to Islamic Circle North America (INCA) in 2023.<sup>18</sup> ICNA is a CAIR affiliate.<sup>19</sup> ICNA has its own documented ties to terrorism.<sup>20</sup> Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Services partnered with ICNA in Georgia, Arkansas, California, Arizona, Texas, Washington, and Pennsylvania.<sup>21</sup> Catholic Charities of Fort Worth also received over \$200 million of federal HHS/ORR funds in 2023.<sup>22</sup> Catholic Charities partnered with ICNA in Texas.<sup>23</sup>

CAIR does not appear as a federal recipient on any federal oversight dashboards, like Sam.gov, because the HHS/ORR contracts are between the states and the non-profits, not directly with the federal government.<sup>24</sup> Yet, CAIR's own press releases and publicity specifically state that CAIR California<sup>25</sup>, CAIR Washington<sup>26</sup>, CAIR Oklahoma<sup>27</sup>, CAIR Florida<sup>28</sup>, and CAIR Texas<sup>29</sup> all provided asylum immigration legal services for the arriving Afghans.

The convoluted Afghan Allies federal funding scheme that flowed from HHS/ORR to the states and then from states to non profits, with no federal oversight, makes it difficult to clearly track all of the subgrants. CAIR likely received federal money as subgrants of HHS/ORR dollars in a fashion similar to the subgrants to ICNA. There is simply not a direct way to track CAIR's receipts with publicly available federal and state transparency portals. Federal investigatory oversight is necessary in order to "follow the money."

CAIR attorneys, like all licensed immigration attorneys, are tasked with screening immigrants for purposes of applying for asylum or other immigration relief. Attorneys are professionally and ethically obligated to ask clients about past associations, organizations clients have supported, and any intent clients may have to engage in or support terrorism.<sup>30</sup> Those obligations should have been central to any organization entrusted with federally funded immigration work.<sup>31</sup> Those questions, in addition to how they are framed, documented, or avoided, are the frontline of national security.

CAIR understood the power of being the federal and state funding immigration provider for Afghan asylum seekers. In its application to the State of California for Afghan immigration funds, CAIR highlighted its experience in navigating terrorism-related inadmissibility grounds, in effect touting its ability to coach clients around the enforcement of such laws.<sup>32</sup> CAIR, an organization with a thirty-year association with Hamas,<sup>33</sup> was entrusted to vet Afghan applicants for terrorism.

In short, the federal government paid CAIR to represent Afghan immigrants, while CAIR undermines the very security and values this country is trying to protect.

Federal oversight is urgently needed to investigate and audit all Afghan immigration grants routed through the states, require transparent reporting for Afghan immigration and refugee legal services, and bar organizations that have ties to a U.S. designated terror organizations from receiving any federal or pass-through funding.

## II. CAIR's Financial Misconduct and Misrepresentation of Legal Status

In 2022, California Department of Social Services (CDSS) awarded CAIR more than \$7.2 million in federal HHS/ORR funding under the Afghan Legal Services Program.<sup>34</sup> However, this grant was not awarded to a legally recognized nonprofit entity. It was awarded to "Council on American-Islamic Relations, Greater Los Angeles," a name not

registered with the California Secretary of State, lacking an EIN, and never authorized to receive federal funds.<sup>35</sup>

Despite receiving more than \$7 million in federal pass-through funding, CAIR of Greater Los Angeles didn't file a federal Tax Form 990 because it's not a stand alone non-profit.<sup>36</sup> But, the state incorporated affiliate CAIR-CA's federal taxes reported \$0 in government grants on its 2022 Form 990 and only \$127,269 in 2023.<sup>37</sup> This represents an extraordinary discrepancy that strongly suggests willful misreporting in violation of the Internal Revenue Code. CAIR-CA also failed to disclose required subgrants on Schedule I.<sup>38</sup>

If it was CAIR-CA that received the federal HHS/ORR funding, and employees of CAIR simply mis-typed and referred to "CAIR of Greater Los Angeles" on the California Department of Social Services contract, then it was CAIR-CA that had contractual obligations to distribute more than \$5 million to partner organizations.<sup>39</sup> Again, no such subgrants are shown on CAIR-CA 990 reporting documents. In fact, public documents from the State of California show that CAIR of Greater Los Angeles sub-granted approximately \$3.6 million of the HHS/ORR money from "CAIR of Greater Los Angeles" to "CAIR of Greater Los Angeles", treating internal branches as if they were separate legal entities, undermining all transparency, and engaging in blatant self-dealing.<sup>40</sup>

Publicly obtained documents show that the State of California expressed concern that CAIR (and all its state affiliates) were under-performing on its Afghan Legal Services Contract. In fact, CAIR-CA delivered less than 50% of the legal representation promised to the California Department of Social Services.<sup>41</sup> In its reporting to the State of California Department of Social Services, CAIR CA reported only 66 affirmative asylum cases in FY 2021-2022 and 71 in FY 2022-2023.<sup>42</sup> CAIR-CA was also the recipient of

the majority of a \$13 million dollar federal HHS/ORR grant routed through the California Department of Social Services to help Afghans assimilate in schools and workplaces.<sup>43</sup> This grant was given to CAIR-CA despite the fact that CAIR purports to be a legal civil rights organization, not an agency of social workers.<sup>44</sup> In short, CAIR-CA accepted tens of millions of dollars of federal funds, assisted few Afghan immigrants, and evaded all federal and state transparency requirements.

### III. Afghan Immigration Vetting

The most serious risk arising from CAIR's federal funding is the national-security threat created when CAIR was entrusted, and paid, by the U.S. government, to conduct terrorism-sensitive immigration screenings for Afghan parolees under Operation Allies Welcome.<sup>45</sup>

Afghan immigration vetting requires probing extremist ideology, organizational ties, and potential support for extremist groups.<sup>46</sup> CAIR's own alignment with extremist narratives creates an inherent conflict of interest. An organization that currently supports Hamas and whose creation was designed to further Hamas ideology cannot credibly assess whether Afghan applicants harbor extremist views.<sup>47</sup> Entrusting such screening to CAIR predictably increases the risk that individuals with extremist affiliations will enter or remain in the United States.

That risk is no longer theoretical. The recent murder of a National Guard member near the U.S. Capitol by an Afghan asylee underscores the deadly consequences of compromised screening systems.<sup>48</sup> When the federal government delegates terrorism-sensitive immigration functions to a pro-Hamas organization, national security is placed at an unacceptable risk.

During the chaos of the Afghan evacuation, there was insufficient time for the U.S. government to go through the complete process to vet and grant evacuees formal refugee

status.<sup>49</sup> As a stopgap measure, the Biden Administration paroled individuals into the United States.<sup>50</sup> The intention was that the Afghans would then seek permanent legal status to remain in the United States.<sup>51</sup>

The money granted from HHS/ORR to the states, and then to individual legal service organizations, was intended for attorneys to assist Afghans with the process of applying for this permanent immigration status, most commonly through asylum applications.<sup>52</sup>

Terrorism related inadmissibility grounds, INA § 212(a)(3)(B) is translated into security screening questions on the asylum application (Form I-589)<sup>53</sup> to ensure that applicants do not have previous involvement with terrorism or extremist groups and do not currently support terrorism.<sup>54</sup> Most immigration forms, including applications for permanent residency (Form I-485) and naturalization (Form N-400) also contains terrorism-screening questions.<sup>55</sup>

As an immigration legal service provider, CAIR was, and still remains, responsible for asking each applicant every question on all immigration forms and properly assessing whether the immigrant applicant has had, or currently has, any associations or beliefs connected to terrorism that could make them ineligible for immigration relief.<sup>56</sup>

#### IV. CAIR's History and Current Terrorism Affiliations

CAIR is not the civil-rights organization it presents itself to be.<sup>57</sup> It was founded by the Muslim Brotherhood's Palestine Committee, a network established by Hamas's

leadership to support Hamas in the United States.<sup>58</sup> In the 2008 Holy Land Foundation prosecution,<sup>59</sup> the largest terrorism-financing case in U.S. history, federal prosecutors introduced extensive evidence showing that CAIR's founders and senior leaders held simultaneous roles in Hamas-affiliated organizations.<sup>60</sup> CAIR was named an unindicted co-conspirator at the Holy Land Foundation trial.<sup>61</sup> In 2009, Federal Judge Jorge Solis upheld that designation, writing: "The government has produced ample evidence to establish the associations of CAIR with Hamas."<sup>62</sup>

Internal Palestine Committee documents show that after Hamas opposed the Oslo Accords, committee operatives, including Nihad Awad, the current national Executive Director of CAIR, met in Philadelphia, under FBI surveillance, to discuss strategies for covertly supporting Hamas.<sup>63</sup> Participants in the Philadelphia meeting referred to Hamas only as "Samah" (Hamas spelled backwards) and emphasized the need for deception.<sup>64</sup> Within months, Palestine Committee figures Omar Ahmad and Nihad Awad incorporated CAIR, which an internal memo soon listed as one of the Committee's Hamas-support organizations.<sup>65</sup>

Today, CAIR's leadership continues to echo that ideology. Following Hamas's October 7, 2023 massacre, CAIR's co-founder Nihad Awad stated he was "happy to see" the assault.<sup>66</sup> CAIR-San Francisco's Executive Director, Zahra Billoo, mourned the killing of Ismail Haniyeh, the chief architect of October 7<sup>th</sup>, and referred to him as a "martyr."<sup>67</sup> CAIR-Los Angeles Executive Director and CEO of CAIR-CA, Hassam Ayloush, asserted that Israel "does not have the right to defend itself," framing Hamas's actions as legitimate resistance.<sup>68</sup> In 2025, CAIR-Ohio's director shared a stage with a

Treasury-designated Hamas leader at an event branded as the Al Aqsa Flood, Hamas's own terminology for the October 7<sup>th</sup> terrorist attack.<sup>69</sup>

In the context of tens of millions of dollars of federal grants, these statements are not protected political discourse. They directly violate federal anti-terrorism certification requirements<sup>70</sup> and expose a profound ideological conflict with the responsibilities CAIR assumed when paid to screen Afghan parolees for terrorism-related inadmissibility.

## V. CAIR's All-of-Society Extremist Influence Campaign

The misuse of federal dollars is inseparable from CAIR's broader effort to embed extremist, anti-democratic, and anti-American action across public institutions. While receiving millions in federal refugee funding, CAIR engaged in an all-of-society campaign to normalize Hamas-aligned ideology and weaponize civic systems for political ends.<sup>71</sup>

CAIR activists have appeared before city councils across California to push narratives that excuse or glorify terrorism.<sup>72</sup> CAIR has successfully inserted its ideological frameworks into K-12 ethnic studies curricula, embedding an oppressor-oppressed worldview that promotes grievance-based identity politics and delegitimizes U.S. counterterrorism policy and Israel's right to exist.<sup>73</sup> CAIR has lobbied school boards, pressured superintendents, and cultivated influence within teacher training programs to institutionalize these views.<sup>74</sup>

CAIR has aggressively infiltrated California's county anti-hate commissions, entities intended to protect vulnerable communities, using them instead to marginalize Jewish

communities and inflate claims of Islamophobia unsupported by evidence<sup>75</sup>. CAIR substituted its own “hate incident findings” for formal California Attorney General reports, distorting statewide anti-hate programming.<sup>76</sup> CAIR likewise commandeered California’s Cal vs. Hate initiative, positioning itself as a civil-rights authority<sup>77</sup> while simultaneously opposing Holocaust education<sup>78</sup> and lobbying against legislation to protect Jewish students in K–12 schools.<sup>79</sup>

CAIR’s penetration of public universities has been equally extensive.<sup>80</sup> It played a central organizing and guidance role in campus encampments, partnering with groups that openly endorse Hamas.<sup>81</sup> The organization’s staff and leadership provided legal, media, and strategic support to student activists whose demands mirrored Hamas political objectives.<sup>82</sup>

This is not standard civic advocacy. It represents a coordinated effort to shift public institutions toward extremist-aligned narratives while benefiting from federal and state funding streams intended to protect the public good.

## VI. Conclusion

The evidence demonstrates that CAIR-California misrepresented its legal structure, concealed federal funds on its tax returns, failed to perform critical services for Afghan refugees, and used public resources to advance extremist-aligned political goals. Most

alarmingly, CAIR's documented ties to Hamas and its leaders' public praise of terrorist violence render it fundamentally unfit to perform terrorism-sensitive immigration screening. Federal and state oversight failures enabled these abuses, jeopardizing public safety, national security, and the integrity of refugee programs designed to protect America's allies.

Immediate federal action is required to suspend CAIR's funding, investigate its conduct, review IRS filings, audit state pass-through agencies, and enact safeguards to prevent extremist-affiliated organizations from accessing federal funds or influencing terrorism-related immigration processes.
